Sketching in Color

The class will be sketching outdoors from nature and in the studio. Sketching is a quicker, more informal approach to drawing and sketching from nature is a wonderful source of inspiration. Surprising and wonderful art can spring forth from this simple process: to look deeply at nature and to let the imagination and inner inspiration lead the way.

We'll use color in all manner of ways. Each medium has its own character and color gives an added dimension. Using color and combining media enlivens and enriches a drawing. The variety of line and color brings energy and character to the work.

On the first day we will concentrate on dry media (pencil, charcoal, colored pencil and pastel) and on the second day on wet media (India ink, sepia, watercolor using both pen and brush).

There will be demonstrations of gesture drawing, contour line drawing, using value and texture, color harmony, perspective and composition. By the end of the workshop, students will have done many drawings from quick sketches to finish works.

Louise Lieber, a California artist, moved to Florida in 2005. She has a BFA from the San Francisco Art Institute and an MFA from Pratt Institute. She lived in New York City for a number of years, teaching and exhibiting her art there, before returning to San Francisco. She has taught drawing, sculpture, ceramics and art history at a number of colleges, universities and community art centers for more than 16 years. Her work in sculpture and drawing has been exhibited in numerous gallery and museum shows. She will be in a two person exhibition, "Encountering the Terrain" at the Art League of Daytona Beach from August 29 thru September 26, 2010.
