

Picturing Peace: A Community Vision Postcard Art and Writing Exhibition **Guidelines and Entry Form**

Eligibility

The Museum of Florida Art's ***Picturing Peace: A Community Vision Postcard Art and Writing Exhibition*** is open to all K-8th grade public, private, and homeschool art students in Brevard, Flagler, Lake, Seminole and Volusia Counties. All entries must be original artworks, created by the student individually, not by a group. Only original works inspired by the theme of Picturing Peace are accepted. Each entry must be submitted with a completed entry form. Only one entry per student will be accepted.

Theme

The exhibition theme is ***Picturing Peace: A Community Vision*** addressing peace issues on a global, community and/or family level such as: violence/abuse within families; confrontation, conflict, bullying and gangs in schools; human rights; connections between hope and unity; transforming feelings of isolation and separation with a sense of connection and a shared vision of cooperation and unity; creating a community of acceptance, respect and tolerance

Submission Specifications

Students are encouraged to creatively express the theme ***Picturing Peace*** in an innovative visual **and** written format. Works will be selected based on theme, composition, originality, organization and content. Each entry **MUST** include an original visual image and a poem, quote, or statement by the student that is inspired by their artwork. Submitted entries must not be plagiarized, stolen, or otherwise copied from any other source. Entries that use copyrighted or trademarked images will not be accepted. Entries not adhering to these conditions will be disqualified.

PAPER SIZE

Overall size is 4 inches x 6 inches with a 1/4 inch border on all sides.

FORMAT

The composition may be vertical or horizontal. The writing may be included on the front of the postcard or on the back. A template for the postcard can be downloaded from the Museum's website, Education page at www.MuseumofFloridaArt.org.

MEDIA

Accepted media are painting, drawing, collage, printmaking, graphics, photography and computer art.

Recognition

Selected submissions will be exhibited in ***Picturing Peace : A Community Vision Student Art Exhibition March 12 – 28, 2010*** with an opening reception on March 12 from 5-7 pm at the Museum of Florida Art. The selected art works will be displayed in the Museum March 12 - 28, 2010.

Submission of Entries and General Information & Rules

1. All works must be submitted with a completed entry form.
2. Artworks that do not meet the submission specifications will not be included in the exhibition.
3. All entries should be delivered to the Museum of Florida Art Monday, March 1 through Friday March 5, 2010 between the hours of 10:00 am and 5:00 pm.
4. The Museum reserves the right to use images of the pieces submitted for promotional or commercial purposes in any medium without payment in regard to publication, exhibition or promotion. The artist will be given named credit for any piece of art so used.

Please note:

All submitted works become the property of the Museum of Florida Art. Submissions will not be returned to the students. After the close of the exhibition, the postcards will be sent to selected organizations such as the UN, Veterans' organizations, the White House, etc. in an effort to promote a community vision of peace.
