The Museum of Florida Art will host nationally acclaimed artist Fran Hardy in a solo exhibition September 14 to November 25.

Hardy's jewel-like paintings explore how the ancient inspires the contemporary. Her style blurs the boundaries between realism and abstraction. Hardy masterfully draws from her experience in a wide variety of media and uses techniques from the distant past such as intaglio printing and the early renaissance technique of oil over egg tempera.

Although she now resides in New Mexico, it was Florida that was the fertile base for Fran Hardy's work and career. She was drawn to Florida by childhood memories of visits to her grandparents who taught her a love of beauty and nature.

Ken Rollins, Director of the Gulf Coast Museum of Art in Largo Florida states of her work, "Fran Hardy is an exceptional painter. With a keen eye, and commitment to craftsmanship, Hardy has developed a style uniquely her own. Fran Hardy's exquisite still life's move beyond representation into an ethereal world that transcends mere documentation. As a contemporary master of an age-old technique, Fran Hardy's work reaffirms the importance of painting in the 21<sup>st</sup> century."

## On Exhibit: Ira Winarsky: *Iridescent Landscapes*

Ira Winarsky is a ceramist and a professor at the University of Florida. Ira is known for his figurative and abstractive sculptural landscapes and landscape vessels, which are enveloped by his memorizing glazes.

Winarsky's unique glazes come from years of research and experimentation. Ira has successfully developed hundreds of iridescent glazes that have become a principal element of his work. "The glazes are the result of fifteen years of passionate original research using thousands of formulae and hundreds of firing techniques. The iridescent glazes include the entire spectrum of visible color. Each glaze reflects its own unique set of light wavelengths, and many reflect all of the colors of the rainbow.," says Winarsky. It is Ira's use of technology and rigorous discipline of recording the process that allow his ideas to come to fruition. However, even with all the technology, each piece of artwork is a gamble. Winarsky describes the transformation of his forms and the unfired milky white glazes as "awesome iridescent panoply of colors that can only be described as breathtakingly magical."

On the exhibition Winarsky explains, "My love of color, landscape, and a new technology has all come together in my iridescent ceramic landscapes. I have produced a rainbow of iridescent luster colors, which interactively change color with the light they are bathed in, and with each person who sees them."
